AORTA has lost a very dear friend and strong ally. David Zagel became active in **AORTA**, shortly after graduating from his beloved University of Oregon. Bright, articulate, compassionate, intelligent and dedicated-- just a few of the words that describe

the young man who joined **AORTA** in the 1990s.

David was born July 24, 1965 in Sydney, Montana to Ronald "Pete" and Ruth Zagel. He left, after making the world a better place, on May 8, 2013. He graduated Valedictorian at Newport High School in 1983. He attended Willamette University in Salem, University of Stuttgart in Germany and graduated from the University of Oregon with a Bachelor of Architecture (second in his class) in 1988.

David served on the **AORTA** Board of Directors in the 1990s, and as Vice-President and President in 1994-96. David's involvement with **AORTA** caught the attention of people at TriMet, and in 1997 he was hired as Project Planner. In 2006 his accomplishments were recognized by URS Corporation, which employed him as Senior Transportation Planner. He continued that position until his death.

In addition to his passion for rail and transit, David was passionate about equal rights for all people and Duck football. He was active with Basic Rights Oregon and a member of the University of Oregon Alumni Association.

David loved to travel around the United States and also visited Germany, France, Spain and other European countries, as well as Japan. David is survived by his mother, Ruth Zagel of Newport; brothers, Jim and his wife, Paula of Brighton, Colorado and Jon and his wife, Darla of Newport; as well as a large community of friends. ()
